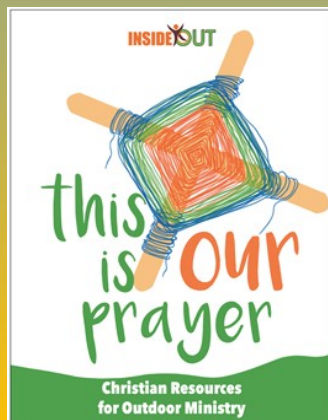

Pricing, Camperships, Discounts

Why 3 Prices? (1) Subsidized (2) Supporters (3) Sustainers

(1) Subsidized Fee is a reduced fee for families who need this option

(2) Supporters Fee is the actual cost of camp

(3) Sustainers Fee is the actual cost of camp, plus a donation to wards the ministry of Brethren Heights.

Camperships

We believe that no child should miss out on camp because of financial barriers. If your camper is in need of financial assistance to attend Camp Brethren Heights, we have funds set aside for partial or full camperships. Camperships are granted on a first come, first served basis. Your church may pay a portion of the camp fee. A response letter will inform families of granted campership requests at the latest two weeks before their scheduled camp.

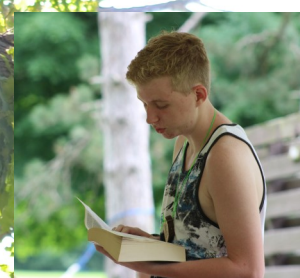

Registering for Camp

- 1) Visit campbrethrenheightsmi.org
- 2) Under the 2020 Summer Camps tab select from the dropdown menu the [Camper Forms link](#) and click on the Summer Camp Registration Form.
- 3) Complete Registration Form
- 4) Return Registration Form to camp via email or postal mail accompanied by a [\\$50.00 deposit](#) due by June 1, 2020. The deposit is non-refundable, unless Camp Brethren Heights cancels your selected program. We'll continue to accept registrations AFTER June 1 up until the first day of camp, as long as that camp is still available.
- 5) Pay by either [mailing a check to the camp](#) or by clicking on the [PayPal button on the camp website](#). Please specify it's for camp registration and name of camper and what camp they are attending. Your balance must be paid in-full prior to the start of camp. Checks are to be made out to [Camp Brethren Heights Inc.](#)

**Note that PayPal takes a small percentage of your payment (2.9%), so please make sure that we receive your full payment.*

Before Your Camper Comes to CBH

Two weeks prior to your camp, we will send you a confirmation packet via email indicating the following: balance due (if any), camper gear list, camper and parent information, check-in procedures, policy guides, health history form and any adventure camp waivers. If you do not receive your confirmation packet within 2 weeks prior to your camp, contact the camp.

The 4 Rules to teach your camper:

1. *Respect all campers and staff; includes personal & camp property*
2. *Obey counselors and camp staff*
3. *No harmful or unsafe behavior (physically, verbally, emotionally)*
4. *Be kind and helpful*
